Clause 3.8.1(i) may be read as 'Within FIVE WEEKS from the date of purchase order at all offices in states other than offices in North Eastern States.'

If the Bank opts to place multiple purchase orders in reference to this tender, each order shall be treated as an independent order and the same shall be governed by the terms and conditions of the tender. However, the specific terms like order value, date of delivery etc. shall be mentioned in absolute terms in each of the POs. Accordingly, separate bank guarantees need to be submitted for each order.

However, it is clarified that the min. 2 USB2.0/e-SATA combo port indicates that the proposed model should have at least 2 USB 2.0 ports or 2 e-SATA combo ports or 1 USB 2.0 & 1 e-SATA combo port.
